INFORMATION AND RULES

March 27nd and March 28th, 2010



EVENT

- Teams may consist of up to 10 skiers. Jackrabbit teams (where the majority of participants are aged 12 & under) may have more than 10 skiers.
- Participants can use either classic or skating technique.

CORPORATE/PROFESSIONAL CHALLENGE

- Those teams entering the corporate/professional challenge must consist entirely of, (i) members of one profession, their employees or spouses, or (ii) employees of one employer and their spouses.
- The team must collect at least \$300 in pledges.

ENTRY FEES

- The entry fee for the event will be \$35 per person (for skiers ages 13+). The entry fee for persons aged 12 & under is \$10 per person.
- This amount is a minimum must be handed in by the time the event begins. Additional pledge money raised must be pledged by the pre-event meeting (11 am March 27th at Lappe Ski Centre) but may be collected until a week after the event (April 3rd).
- We encourage everyone to help raise pledges as this event is a Fundraiser for the NTDC and the Lappe Ski Centre improvement fund. There will be some awesome prizes for the individual, the team and the family to raise the most money in pledges!
- Cheques should be made payable to the National Team Development Centre (NTDC).

REGISTRATIONS

- To register please complete the appropriate team registration form.
- Please have each participant from your team sign the form or where appropriate, have their parent/guardian sign the form.

PRE-EVENT MEETING

- There will be a pre-event meeting in the Lappe ski chalet at 11:00 am on March 27th, 2010.
- This meeting must be attended by at least one representative from each team.
- At the meeting we will expect you to turn over all of your pledge sheets to the event coordinator and, if you have not already done so, pay your registration fee.
- After the event is over, kilometres skied will be certified by the event coordinator. The pledge sheets will then be turned back over to the team contact person so that pledges can be collected.
- We are asking that all pledges be collected within a week of the event, and that the team contact person provide a brief accounting confirming the total amount each team has collected.

THE RULES

1. At a minimum we ask that each team member ski 10 or more kilometers (with the exception of Jackrabbit age children).
2. Only one skier for each team will be skiing qualifying kilometers at any time. To keep recording of distance as simple as possible, we will have one well marked loop to be skied day and night.
3. We will have a 20 or 30 meter long tag zone and require teams to make exchanges in this area only. You must have hand-to-hand or hand-to-body contact.
4. Everyone who is skiing must wear a bib and every time they ski past the timing area they must ensure that they turn towards the bib recorders so that their bib number can be clearly seen and recorded. Skiing on course is allowed while not on a team leg, however individuals doing so must ensure that their bib is covered and must not ski through the finish lane/exchange zone.
5. The clock stops at 12 noon on Sunday, March 28th. A gunshot blast signals the end of the event. Skiers stop where they are on the course and wait for a course marshal to mark their location so that we can determine the exact number of kilometers skied by your team.
